Cooperator Agrees to:

- Pay **\$21/acre** for the custom no-till seeding minimum. charge for the service is **\$840 (40 acres min.)**
- The District reserves the right to limit each producer to **160** acres of custom seeding, depending on workload.
- Acres will be based on current FSA maps. Maps required on all fields to be seeded along with copies of seed tags and/or seed mix data sheets showing the recommended planting rate in pounds per acre.
- Agreement needs to be signed before seeding begins. Payment due 30 days after the billing date. Interest will be added after 30 days.
- The district retains the right to decline custom seeding on any field due to adverse field conditions that may limit proper seeding (rough, rocky, excessive weeds, or residue, etc.). It is the cooperators responsibility to provide field conditions suitable for seeding.
- To deliver clean seed, inoculants or other material to the seeding site at the time of planting and to assist district personnel in loading the seed into the air seeder tank.
- A companion crop or carrier must be mixed in with all grass seed to aid in the feeding and metering of the bulky seed through the air seeder. At minimum, this should be 10lbs of oats or equivalent per acre.
- The District will try to provide cooperatives with 2-3 day’s notice before tentatively planning to seed. If the cooperator isn’t ready for the custom seeding for whatever reason, there will be no guarantees that it will be seeded.
- The cooperator shall indemnify and hold harmless the District, employees and agents from any and all liability or claims in connection with this agreement or the equipment.
- It is further understood that the Williams County Soil Conservation District:
 - Does not guarantee an established grass/crop stand.
 - Is not responsible for any undesirable plants that may emerge with the grass or cover crops.
 - That the seeding program is not intended to be a landscaping program but rather is intended for agricultural purposes and the district will not be held to a higher standard of landscape quality.
